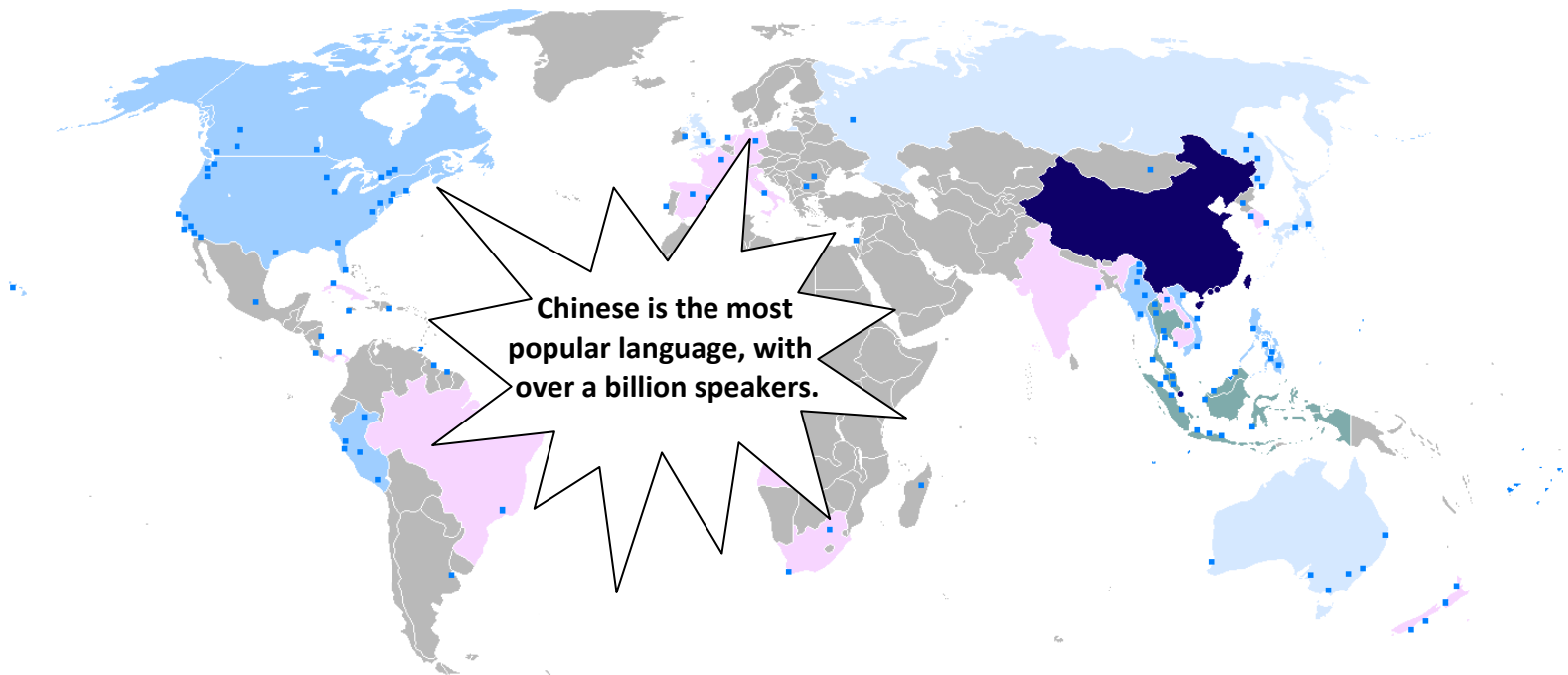

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

CHIN& 121-123 (*Elementary Chinese*) is a comprehensive beginning Chinese course, which includes instruction and practice in all four language skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing.

CHIN& 221-223 (*Intermediate Chinese*) is a series of intermediate courses that offer a complete review of grammar and increased conversation. Students will read short pieces of literature of increasing complexity and do writing assignments on varied topics. History, and/or culture will also be studied.
